Best patterns zonkers, minkies, any fry imitations and small buzzer patterns in black to olive.

- Fishing on 2 miles of the River Coquet where you have the opportunity to catch salmon, sea trout and wild brown trout (in season).

- A well stocked lake which is re-stocked on a weekly basis and has a large stock of resident, over-wintered rainbow and brown trout of superb quality
